

P02 – Board Orders, Bulletins, Notices & Guidelines

Policy

The Automobile Insurance Rate Board (AIRB) may issue and/or enforce:

- Orders to require filings under section 5.1 of the Automobile Insurance Premiums Regulation or to communicate written decisions including the annual adjustment of premium level for the Grid.
- > Bulletins to communicate to industry on issues requiring action or future compliance.
- Notices to communicate information to industry and stakeholders not requiring action.
- Guidelines to communicate requirements and expectations for the preparation of full and simplified filings, including technical guidance.

Authority

The AIRB's authority is provided under the Automobile Insurance Premiums Regulation (Premiums Regulation). The Premiums Regulation gives the AIRB the authority to:

- Require any information it considers necessary; and
- Specify the manner and form in which information is required to be filed with the AIRB.

Procedures

Disclosure

All approved Orders, Bulletins and Notices and Guidelines are issued and posted on the AIRB website.

Compliance

All insurers transacting automobile insurance in Alberta must comply with applicable Orders, Bulletins, Notices and Guidelines issued or enforced by the AIRB, within the applicable timeframe.
